




15 NORFOLK ROCKLAND ST MARY

The cakes and custard tarts at Teles patisserie are local legends. Pastry chef Joaquim Teles has been baking for 30 years and opened his pastry shop and café in 2018 near the Yare Valley farm shop, where you can pick up local juice, jam and cold-pressed oils. Add in a waterside pub serving toffee waffle cheesecake and an appetite-building hike through the Broads and you have a great walk with big skies and wildlife.



The village of Elterwater, home to the excellent Britannia Inn, sits in the middle of Great Langdale, one of the Lake District's most recognisable valleys. This walk skirts the wooded slopes of Lingmoor Fell and Little Langdale Tarn to Slater Bridge, a 17th-century stone packhorse

bridge described by Alfred Wainwright as 'the most picturesque footbridge in Lakeland'. After a detour to the impressive cavern of Cathedral Quarry, next comes Hodge Close, after which the huge, flooded and abandoned quarry complex at moated island. At end of track, turn R by lane into Claxton.



Start/parking National Trust Elterwater car park, grid ref NY3328047

Is it for me? A beautiful Lake District walk without a big climb, on well-used paths; there are still some steep and rocky sections

prevail through the woods of Oxen Fell, leading to the waterfalls of Colweth Force and Skelwith Force, before a final amble along the Cumbria Way, following the River Brathay and the shore of Elter Water back to the start.




GRADIENT PROFILE


footpath to Birk Howe Farm. Go R, signposted 'Slater's Bridge', with views across Little Langdale Tarn to Wetherlam. Two gates and kissing gate lead to Slater Bridge.

2 1¾ miles/2.7km
Cross, then cross stone stile, field and kissing gate; go L. Through gate, bear R over stile and climb to Langdale Quarries: short tunnel R leads to Cathedral Quarry. Leave, go R then drop L to climb down via stone steps back to track. Continue E, downstream. At bridge don't cross: go R, then fork L, towards Elterwater. At Stang End take byway R towards Hodge Close.

Continue S, through four gates and past houses, until Hodge Close quarry appears L. At Stang End take byway R towards Hodge Close.

3 miles/4.8km
At quarry foot go L, through gate, then L again on bridleway on other side of quarry. Through gate go R towards High Oxen Fell. At farm, through gate, follow tarmac then bear L on Public Way towards A593. Near main road go L, then R through gate onto bridleway for Colwith. Through woods, drop to junction by wall and go L. At junction keep ahead to river, then L upstream to see Colwith Force waterfall.

4 5½ miles/8.5km
Return downstream, following river to stile or gate



Continue along pavement. Reaching village green, turn L into Mill Lane and keep straight through gate. Continue on bridleway beside reed-fringed waterway.

3 ½ miles/5.5km

Reaching River Yare near Beauchamp Arms, turn L along riverside embankment. After about ¾ mile, follow path L by straight waterway to Rockland Broad. Keep on around edge of Rockland Broad, water on R. Continue through gates, follow path beside waterway and turn R on pavement past New Inn and Rockland Straithe car park.

4 5½ miles/9km
Turn R down Green Lane with Wherryman's Way arrow.

Keep straight beyond Broad Hall Farm and continue along grassy track between fields. Just beyond hedge, turn R and soon L with trees on R.

Follow the track alongside Surlingham Wood to reach Wheatfen Reserve (aka Ted Ellis nature reserve).

5 6¼ miles/10km

This reserve, with its walkways and waterways, is well worth exploring. Map by car park shows walks around Wheatfen Broad and woods. When you've finished exploring, return to car park and continue along tree-lined track you arrived on. Look out for farm shop sign and follow L along path. Turn R into farmyard. Follow signs for shop/café.



Continue along grassy path with hedges on L. Keep straight towards houses ahead, turn R by fences and L on footpath to lane. Bus stop and car park nearby. CW

6 ½ miles/10.5km

Turn L past farm shop and keep straight along farm drive. Turn R onto Mill Road, soon L along Holloway Road. After about 350m, turn L on grassy path with trees on L. Walk past small wood, turn L by far side and soon R by big field. Turn R again along far side and follow path L with hedges on L.

Keep straight towards houses ahead, turn R by fences and L on footpath to lane. Bus stop and car park nearby. CW

7 miles/11.2km
Turn L past farm shop and keep straight along farm drive. Turn R onto Mill Road, soon L along Holloway Road. After about 350m, turn L on grassy path with trees on L. Walk past small wood, turn L by far side and soon R by big field. Turn R again along far side and follow path L with hedges on L.

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
