
24 DUMFRIES & GALLOWAY WISP HILL & GREY HILL

Distance: 12.2km/7½ miles Time: 5 hours Grade: Moderate







CHOSEN BY NICK HALLISSEY This walk explores the untrodden hills

and vallevs of Scotland's Eskdale, from the summit of Grev Hill to the twisting White Esk river, Expect huge views across a vast and empty upland from Grey Hill on a good day. Afterwards you can visit Samye Ling, the largest Tibetan monastery in western Europe, which is just up the road - and even stay the night there, if you want a complete break from the norm.

Start

Follow road south and round bend, L, crossing bridge over river. Where road bends R. continue ahead on access track

to Clerkhill Farm (footpath sign for Grev Hill). Climb track towards farm, ignoring branching track L. Just before farm, turn L with footpath sign. then after 100 yards (sign) go through gate to emerge on hillside. Turn R (fence and farm R) and follow path over brow of hill. At far corner of field, go through kissing-gate and follow rough path up valley with river R. Path is boggy in places but then joins farm track. Continue on track to reach ford.

2km/1½ miles

Cross with care then branch R away from track. following path uphill towards plantation on horizon. Reaching crest of ridge, follow plantation fenceline R across





reach the summit of Grev Hill (fine views here).

7 4km/2½ miles Veer I (north) and follow indistinct path which eventually firms up into a descending track, crossing the northern flank of Wisp Hill. At bottom (Raeburnside), veer R at small tin-roof barn and head across meadow to far right corner and reach riverside. Turn L on rough path beside river to reach footbridge at Raeburnside farm. Turn R to cross bridge.

6.1km/3¾ miles Turn L on track, through gate and continue to junction with another track Turn R and follow this track, crossing cattle grid and climbing gradually. Descend far side to reach crossroads of tracks just above Moodlaw cottage.

7.3km/4½ miles Turn L and follow track through small plantation and down to riverside. Follow river for just under a mile, passing through gate and past old



charabanc coach to re-enter Eskdale valley (Samye Ling monastery in view ahead).

8.8km/5½ miles Just before river, branch L across meadow, climbing steep bank. Follow track around contour of hillside, continuing

S. Path becomes track as it rounds earthworks of fort, then descends to Raeburnfoot farm R on farm track then take second track R. Follow back to Clerkhill Farm. Then R and retrace steps down access track to road, across bridge and round bend to start. CW
